In 1981, Lyeth Estate was founded in Sonoma County by Chip Lyeth. After having traveled through Bordeaux in the late 1970s, Chip came to believe what the Bordelais had known for centuries: that through blending, you could create a beautiful, distinctive wine, with unique characteristics often very different from the varietals from which it is created. To craft these wines, he brought on his close friend, Bill Arbios.

The wine...

Sonoma County is one of the most prestigious and historic wine-producing regions, with its warm days and cool nights it is perfectly suited to zinfandel. Cooler temperatures preserve zinfandel's juicy acidity and allows for the grape tannins to mature nicely.

With a rich burgundy red color, this 2006 L de Lyeth Zinfandel envelops the senses with warm scents of black cherry and raspberry. On the palate, tantalizing flavors of dark berry mingle with savory spices of cumin, anise and cinnamon. The vintage would match well with a parmesan risotto or a flank steak broiled with brie and basil.
