■ **Poetry Inn, Cliff Lede Vineyards, Napa, California**

Situated on a hillside overlooking vineyards in Napa's Stag's Leap District, this award-winning inn has been meticulously designed for guests to relax and enjoy the incredible scenery. Best known for its cabernet sauvignon, the winery even offers a "cab" mud wrap at its spa. cliffledevineyards.com; poetryinn.com

■ **The Retreat at Chapel Hill Winery, McLaren Vale, South Australia**

With only 10 bedrooms overlooking expansive views of the vineyard, this is truly an exclusive escape. Guests at the converted 1800s Methodist chapel can take cooking classes on-site or simply wind down with a glass of Chapel Hill's highly rated shiraz. chapelhillwine.com.au

■ **Il Boscareto Resort, Beni di Bataciolo Vineyards, Piemonte, Italy**

This five-star resort's modern architecture offers a dramatic contrast to the historic castles and rolling hills of the region. ■ **Cave B Inn & Spa, Quincy, Washington**
