Just a big 'juice' box

For wine-drinking adults whose Easter baskets also need filling, there is a new rabbit that recently hopped into the area.

French rabbit made its U.S. debut this year with four varietals from the Languedoc Roussillon region of France: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

What makes rabbit wines stand out from the crowd, aside from their one-liter size (two more glasses than a 750-ml bottle), is their biodegradable containers. The wines are packaged in what look like grown-up juice boxes.

They retail for \$9.99 a box and are available throughout New Jersey.
